How many students can attend the visit/workshop?

This visit/workshop can accommodate a minimum of 40 and a maximum of 100 students.

Is the workshop suitable for students with special educational needs?

Yes, the workshop is fully inclusive and suitable for all students. For students who may require some additional support, it is recommended that an accompanying adult from the school assist during the visit.

Can the accompanying adults from school leave the students unsupervised during the visit/workshops and re-join after the experience?

No, students must be supervised by the accompanying adults (above 21 years old) at all times.

Will teachers have access to the content of the workshop to prepare students in advance?

As the workshop is interactive and hands on, students will be provided with all the information and instructions they need during the workshop.
